Project Presentation

The project aims to preserve, transmit, and celebrate Luxembourgish traditions, especially those that are lesser-known or undocumented. Through culinary workshops, intergenerational encounters, creative formats, and the development of a game, it fosters dialogue, strengthens the sense of belonging, and highlights the cultural diversity of the country. By exploring everyday life, cuisine, religion, and regional customs, the project invites everyone to (re)discover Luxembourg and to collectively build a living and inclusive cultural memory.

Main Objectives

- Preserve and transmit lesser-known Luxembourgish traditions by collecting oral stories from older adults through interviews conducted by young people.
- Encourage intergenerational and intercultural dialogue by involving participants of all ages and backgrounds, ensuring inclusive participation.
- Create a multilingual illustrated book and an educational game, to be presented at local events.

Target Audiences

- Young people and older adults collaborate to highlight cultural heritage through the creation of a game.
- Newcomers enrich intercultural dialogue, while socio-cultural professionals support the implementation and dissemination of the project.
- General public: invited to discover these traditions during local events.
