Project Presentation

Traditioun (on)perfekt is a participatory project that revisits Luxembourgish traditions through a contemporary and inclusive lens, highlighting food, language, rituals, and social habits within a multicultural society. Through cooking workshops, intergenerational encounters, and creative formats, the project creates a space for dialogue where traditions—sometimes forgotten or transformed—are shared and reinterpreted with humor and warmth.

Led by On.perfekt, in partnership with Anne's Kitchen and the Rural Museum of Binsfeld, the project invites everyone to pass on their stories, tastes, and customs. It encourages the collective creation of a living and inclusive cultural memory that reflects Luxembourg's diversity and strengthens social cohesion through convivial and creative experiences.

Main Objectives

- Participatory workshops combining heritage and contemporary creation.
- Community-based collection of recipes, modernized by Anne's Kitchen.
- Creation of an interactive exhibition with several stations accessible without a moderator

Target Audiences

- Anyone living in Luxembourg, regardless of origin, language, or length of residence.
- Open to children, adults, newcomers, and long-term residents alike.

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
