Project Presentation

Chemins Croisés is an intergenerational and intercultural walking project that takes participants through different regions of Luxembourg. By combining gentle physical activity, the discovery of Luxembourgish traditions, and exchanges between people of diverse backgrounds (residents, refugees, newcomers), the project aims to strengthen social cohesion and highlight lesser-known local traditions. Each walk becomes a moment of encounter, transmission, and dialogue around a Luxembourgish tradition, in a participatory and inclusive spirit.

Main Objectives

- Highlight Luxembourgish traditions through cultural walks.
- Build intercultural bridges between residents, refugees, and newcomers.
- Encourage gentle and accessible physical activity.
- Strengthen belonging, dialogue, and social cohesion.

Target Audiences

- Adults (18+): residents, DPI/BPI applicants, refugees, newcomers (EU/third countries), and cross-border workers.
- Mixed groups for each walk, with priority given to cultural and social diversity.
