The project proposes to explore the Cultural Routes of the Council of Europe through 12 participatory urban walks organised across the Grand Duchy of Luxembourg. Residents share their memories, experiences and their connection to the territory. Guided by mediators, historians and illustrators, these stories are transformed into multilingual graphic narratives, at the crossroads of living memory, heritage, and citizen creativity.

Main Objectives

- Create intercultural bridges between residents and newcomers.
- Encourage gentle and accessible physical activity.
- Strengthen belonging, dialogue, and social cohesion.

Target Audiences

- Residents of Luxembourg, of all ages and backgrounds.
- In particular: newcomers, cross-border workers, young people, seniors, history enthusiasts, volunteers.
- Direct involvement of guides, historians, artists, illustrators, videographers, and project coordinators.
